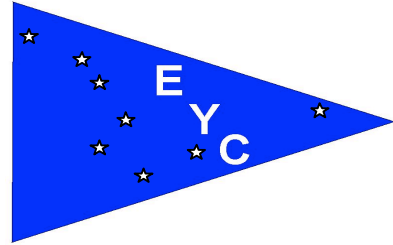

Spring Series, May 31, June 7, 14th, 21th 2015

Notice of Race

1. Venue

The Spring Series organized by the Edmonton Yacht Club (EYC) in conjunction with Sunshine Bay Yacht Club (SBYC) will be held at Seba Beach on the west end of Lake Wabamun, Alberta.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

3. Eligibility

Entry is open to all sailors who hold valid Membership of a Sail Canada/ASA affiliated club. Temporary membership will be available to non-members. Payment by cash or check only, sorry no Visa or Interact, checks must be made payable to "Edmonton Yacht Club".

4. Classes

All cruisers, registered by 10:30 AM on race day will constitute a class.

5. Schedule

Sunday, May 31st, June 7th, 14th, 21nd

10:00 – 10:30	Registration, May 31st only
10:30	Skippers meeting, May 31st only
12:00	Warning signal, First race of the day

Please note, both the Spring Series Regatta has it's own registration process and entry fee.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 One race must be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 When fewer than 5 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 6.3 When 5-8 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 6.4 When 9 or more races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 6.5 Scoring will be based on PHRF Time on Time (TOT) ratings as determined by a EYC/SBYC rating committee.

7. Entry Fees for Spring Series

Cruisers \$ 30.00

8. Sailing Instructions

Will be available upon completion of registration at Edmonton Yacht Club

9. Amendments

Any amendment to this notice will be posted on our website no later than 5 days before race day.

12. Course

Cruiser course will be a windward-leeward course.

13. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in this regatta at their own risk, see rule 4. Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

14. Insurance

Valid liability insurance is the responsibility of all participants.

15. Radio Communication

Boats will not send or receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction applies to cellular phones. Race management will communicate with the race fleet on channel 72.

16. Awards

Prices will be awarded to the top finishers in all classes. Prices will be award as follows:

2-5 boats:	1 st Place
6-9 boats	1 st & 2 nd Place
10 or more boats	1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd place

Trophies will be presented on Sunday June 21, 2015 one hour following completion of the last race.

17. Rights to use name and likeness

In participating in this event, a competitor automatically grants the Organizing authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use or show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.
