

Notice of Race, Spring Series **June 24th & 25th, 2023**

1. Venue

The Spring Series organized by the Edmonton Yacht Club (EYC) in conjunction with the Sunshine Bay Yacht Club (SBYC) will be held at Seba Beach on the west end of Lake Wabamun, Alberta.

2. Rules

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2 Only the measurement rules of participating classes will apply.
- 2.3 Any class requiring the registration number of a boat to be the sail number is waived. In the event of duplicate sail numbers the organising authority reserves the right to have the sail number altered. Sail numbers may not be changed without permission from the race committee prior to racing with the new number.
- 2.4 Appendix P, Immediate penalties for breaking rule 42, as modified by the sailing instructions, will apply.

3. Advertising

This regatta is classified as a category C event.

4. Eligibility

Entry is open to all sailors who hold valid Membership of a CYA affiliated club.

Temporary membership will be available to non-members.

4. Classes

The race is open to all classes of monohull keel boats. Boats will sail in the Handicap class.

6. Scoring

- 6.1 Eight (8) races are scheduled and one race must be complete to constitute a series.
- 6.2 When fewer than 4 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 6.3 When 5-7 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 6.4 When 8 races are completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

7. Safety

A boat which retires from a race will notify the race committee or patrol boat before leaving the race area, or if impossible to do so, immediately after returning ashore. Competitors failing to do so may be scored DNC.
